MUSIC IN THE GARDEN


A celebration of bespoke music of all genres, including world fusion, choirs and orchestral performances, in traditional and contemporary musical styles from the region and the world.



Expo 2020 is conveniently located between Dubai and Abu Dhabi and just 30 minutes from Downtown Dubai. Easily accessible via: Metro Train, Expo Rider, bus and taxi/e-hail. Designed as a car-free zone, Expo is perfect for getting around by foot.
